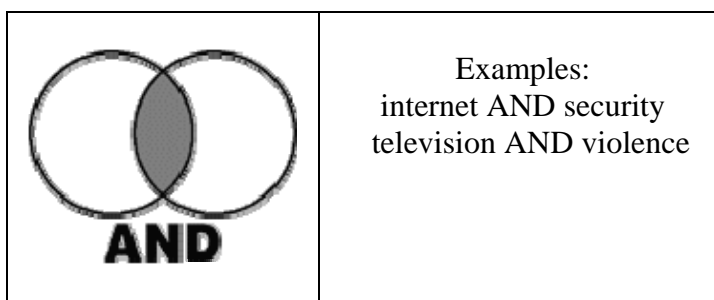


Combining Search Terms with Boolean Logic

Using **AND**, **OR**, and **NOT** to combine keywords in a search allows you to narrow or broaden your search:

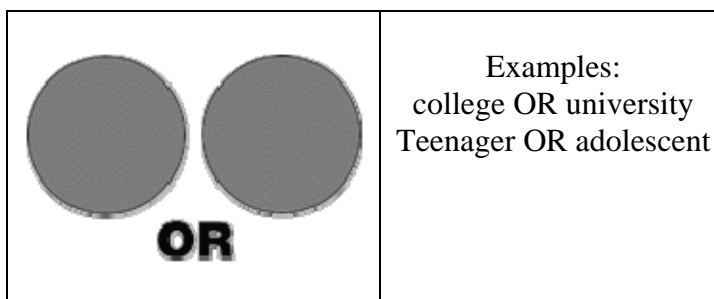
AND

AND narrows a search. Both terms must be present in any references you retrieve. You get only the gray portion where the terms both occur.



OR

OR expands a search. Either or both of the terms are present in the references you retrieve. You get all of both circles.



NOT

NOT narrows a search, excluding a term. Records with the first term will be retrieved, but any records with the second term will be eliminated. The gray circle is pared down.
